

If the battle of David and Goliath were to take place today in San Francisco, David would most likely look like Northern California Super Lawyer Christopher B. Dolan. Recently Chris brought this conviction to bear in recovering a \$61 million verdict, the largest in the history of the Fair Employment and Housing Act, against FedEx Ground, for his two Arab clients who had suffered harassment and a hostile environment based on their race/national origin. To the lawyers in the San Francisco legal community Dolan is known as a zealous and worthy adversary, fighting for the rights of the individual against the unparalleled resources of the government, Fortune 500 businesses and insurance companies who unfairly deny people their legal rights and just compensation. According to Dolan, his philosophy is simple: knowledge is power and that power, in the hand of a skilled, educated advocate can affect justice, even when your opponent is a giant. "David had his rock, we have the truth, and the law, as our weapons."

SUPERLAWYER Dolan is a magna cum laude graduate of the Georgetown University Law Center with a master's degree in management, as first scholar, from Boston University. He is AV rated, Martindale-Hubbell's highest national rating for both ability and ethics. He has been repeatedly nominated by his peers in the San Francisco Trial Lawyers Association (SFTLA) as the outstanding Trial Lawyer of the Year. Dolan says, "as far back as I can remember I believed in standing against injustice."

In 1995, he opened The Dolan Law Firm, now in The Dolan Building in the Financial District. His first jury trial in Marin, against the State of California, for a young motorcyclist, resulted in a unanimous jury verdict for \$2.4 million. Chris has gone on to build his practice into one of the largest plaintiff's firms in San Francisco with eight lawyers and a 16-member support staff. He has tried more than 40 cases to verdict (with an impressive 38 wins and only two losses), recording numerous, significant, multimillion-dollar results for his clients. He serves on the board of directors

of the California Consumer Attorneys, the San Francisco Trial Lawyers Association and is a member of Trial Lawyers for Public Justice and was selected to the Million Dollar Advocates Forum.
